### Relaunch Sunday, June 11, 2023

### Why we go to The Well

Hey Friends! I'm going to give you a little preview of the message this week in our newsletter if that's ok with you. It's our relaunch Sunday of The Well at Centerville and what better story to discuss than that of our namesake. When we read about the Woman at the Well in John chapter 4 it's important to understand the why. Why was she coming to the well? Why was she coming at this time of day? Why didn't she leave? Why did Jesus choose this appointed time to do his work in such an unconventional way? Whys are often confusing for us as believers. We want to know all the answers. More than that we want to know why someone was compelled to act in a way that seems counterintuitive or even counterproductive. I knew that person a long time ago but now they seem different. Why? Then we meet Jesus for ourselves.

Jesus has a habit of changing the story in the lives of those we read in the Bible and in who we are some 2000 years later. The woman's original intentions were to simply get water; her why. She needed water for her responsibilities and to quench her thirst. Those are our basic human needs engrained in us from the very beginning of time. But Jesus intervenes in a powerful way that not only changes her reasons for coming to the well but the very trajectory of her life. When we meet Jesus at the well what we find is that what we receive and our original intentions for coming to the well are dramatically different and can be life changing if we allow it.

Why did you come to The Well? Now, at the time the name was different. We've talked about this at length. Even though the name has changed the church is still the people who make it what it is. Why did you come? More importantly, what did you find that kept you here or changed your life in such a way that you left differently than how you came? How did your why change after meeting Jesus at The Well?

The why is important because there is no more powerful way to invite someone to The Well than to tell them what God did for you when you met Him there yourself. If your life was truly changed it's a story much like the Woman at the Well. She came with only a desire to receive a small amount of water for the day but left with living water that lasts for eternity. She came with a basic need but left with a love that covers a multitude of sins like no other. When she left, she went and told everyone her Why! Why she was different after her encounter at The Well and why Jesus was so important to the new person she has become.

The reason we give you this insight this week is because we want you to give an invitation. Even today with all our social media, the number one way to encourage someone to come to church is through a personal invitation. Yes, you can simply ask someone to come to church. That's absolutely fine. But I would encourage you, if you have the opportunity, the next time you are inviting someone to church to share with them your why. Why you go to The Well. Share how you met Jesus. Share how you came for community but found family. Share how you wanted to just have a basic need met through one of our ministries but found living hope in Jesus. You never know what God can do with your story. But you'll never know if your story can be used if you don't share it. It's not hard, it's just telling people why we go to The Well.


