Uniquely You

Luke 12:7

7 Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.

Everyone is unique in their characteristics and individual identities. You may like mayo on your hamburger while the person next in line can't stand the thought. There's nothing about it that makes one person wrong or one person right; they're just different. That's what a friend told me several years ago when we were discussing differing opinions on a church matter. He said, one person isn't wrong, one person isn't right, they're just different and different is ok.

This was the first lesson of many in learning how to work with people in the church. Unfortunately, this lesson would be reiterated a few years later but from another perspective. I've sat in meetings where if the volunteer or prospective employee doesn't fit all the criteria on a personality level, they are not a viable candidate for ministry. The lesson I learned from that experience was that everyone has a place and everyone has a calling. One assessment of my personality doesn't determine my ability or effectiveness for ministry. I can't say one person can't do a job based on what I think their potential is; it's not the way God works. I or they may need to do things a different way or work in a different format, but it doesn't mean we can't accomplish all God has for us because someone says my personality doesn't fit.

Moses didn't think he had it, Paul was probably considered "too much" for some, and Job was more than likely one depressing individual to be around. Despite all their shortcomings and personality differences, they were still uniquely themselves and uniquely equipped to deal with what God called them to do. This week I want to encourage you to be uniquely who God called you to be. You were not designed to be someone else or to accomplish someone else's mission. You were created to be uniquely you in this season of Advent, different is just different and that's ok.






Basic ERT Training & Chainsaw Safety Class


